



# 72-HOLE STROKE PLAY APRIL 20 - 23, 2023

Mid-Pacific Country Club - Lanikai, Hawai'i COURSE:

TOURNAMENT:

72-hole stroke play USGA Rules and Local Mid-Pacific Open Rules shall apply. The tournament champion shall be the player with the lowest 72-hole gross score. In the event of a tie, a sudden death playoff will determine the winner of the tournament.

- 1. The 2023 MPCC Open Tournament Committee has set a field limit of 170 players and approved or sponsor-exempt golf professionals.
- 2. After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties. There will not be a separate cut for the following flights: The Senior Professional Championship within the tournament will be determined by scores from Round 1 and Round 2 of the tournament. The Senior Amateur Championship within the tournament will be determined by scores from Round 1 and Round 2 of the tournament.
- 3. Participants in A and B Flights will be teeing off from the same tee as the Professional and Championship Flights.
- 4. Electric carts will be provided during tournament play. Two carts per foursome.
- 5. Players must register with starter 20 minutes prior to tee time.
- 6. Tee times for Thursday and Friday will be posted after 12 noon Saturday, April 15, 2023.

The Professional and Championship flights will have tee times on Thursday afternoon and Friday morning. A and B flights will have tee times on Thursday morning and Friday afternoon.

- 7. The Committee has the right to change a person's flight upon entry or after 36 holes of play.
- 8. Players shall be responsible to have a digital device that connects to the internet for the purpose of recording scores into Golf Genius.
- 9. All Professionals in this event will adhere to the policies and governance of the PGA of America Aloha Section.
- 10. All participants shall adhere to the policies of Mid-Pacific Country Club while on property, including the day of the practice round.
- 11. DRESS CODE: While on property, players shall present a neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming. Blue jeans, cutoff shorts, T-shirts with no collar shall not be worn; this includes the practice round. During the competition, all Professionals shall wear long pants and adhere to the Tournament Standards of Competition as outlined by the Aloha Section PGA. These conditions will be strictly enforced by the Committee.

FLIGHTS:

Two Professional flights and four Amateur flights with a GHIN Index not exceeding 10.0\*

All entrants must have a **GHIN number** with entry form.

Players LOWEST GHIN Index in the last 12 months as of Wednesday, April 5 will be used to determine flights.

Approximate flight breakdown: Champion up to 3.9 index; A 4.0 - 7.4 index; B 7.5 -10.0 index.

(Flight spread for each flight may be adjusted, depending on entries, (+ or - .5)

Note: Senior Professional flight for players age 50 and older and Senior Amateur flight (index 3.9 or lower) for players 55 or older, as of April 20, 2023.

AWARDS: \$65,000 Cash - Professionals/Seniors Professionals

\$10,000 Merchandise Certificates - Amateurs/Senior Amateurs

AMATEURS ONLY (Please make sure your GHIN number is ACTIVE or your entry will be placed on HOLD.)

PRIZE PURSES ARE APPROXIMATELY BASED ON SPONSORSHIPS AND ENTRIES AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE COMMITTEE.

**ENTRY FEE:** Professional Entry Fee: \$1,500 (Out-of-State Professional)

\$ 950 (PGA Professional)

\$ 525 (Hawaii Resident Professional)

\$ 475 (Aloha Section Member)

Amateur Entry Fee: \$450 (Non-GHIN Member) \$400 (GHIN Member)

Professional entry status shall be regulated by the Aloha Section PGA's eligibility policies. For questions regarding your entry status please contact : Aloha Section PGA

ALL Non-GHIN member entries will be subject to a <u>temporary hold</u> for committee review. Applications will be rejected if the information submitted below is inconclusive.

Entry Fee includes cart & green fees for tournament dates, one practice round (green fees only). There will be no banquet events this year.

DEADLINE:

Entry forms and applicable fees due at ALOHA SECTION PGA Office by Wednesday, April 5, 2023 at 4:30pm. Players not among the first 170 entries accepted will be put on a waitlist.

All late entries (received after the April 5 deadline) will be accepted on a space available basis and assessed an additional \$100.00 late charge.

CANCELLATIONS: Refunds will be paid to cancellations made by April 5, 2023.
