## 72-HOLE STROKE PLAY

APRIL 25 - 28, 2024

COURSE

Mid-Pacific Country Club - Lanikai, Hawai'i

### TOURNAMENT

72-hole stroke play USGA Rules and Local Mid-Pacific Open Rules shall apply. The tournament champion shall be the player with the lowest 72-hole gross score. In the event of a tie, a sudden death playoff will determine the winner of the tournament.

- The 2024 MPCC Open Tournament Committee has set a field limit of 170 players and approved or sponsor-exempt golf professional.
- After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties. There will not be a separate cut for the following flights: The <u>Senior Professional Division</u> within the tournament will be determined by scores from **Round 1** and **Round 2** of the tournament. The <u>Senior Amateur Division</u> within the tournament will be determined by scores from **Round 1** and **Round 2** of the tournament.
- Participants in A and B Flights will be teeing off from the same tee as the Professional and Championship Flights
- Electric carts will be provided during tournament play. Two carts per foursome.
- Players must register with the starter 20 minutes prior to tee time.
- Tee times for Round #1 & Round #2 will be posted after 12:00 PM on Friday, April 19, 2024.
- The committee shall determine flights for each division and may adjust the index by +/- (0.5) depending on total entries.
- The committee has the right to change a person's flight upon entry or anytime after 36 holes of play.
- Players shall be responsible to have a digital device that connects to the internet for the purpose of recording scores into Golf Genius.
- Approved USGA devices that measure or gauge distance only will be allowed during the tournament. 10.
- All Professionals in this event will adhere to the policies and governance of the Aloha Section PGA.

#### DIVISIONS

Two Professional flights and four Amateur flights with a GHIN Index not exceeding 10.0\*

All entrants must have a GHIN number with entry form.

Players LOWEST GHIN Index in the last 12 months as of Wednesday, April 3 will be used to determine flights

Approximate flight breakdown: Champion up to 3.9 index; A 4.0 - 7.4 index; B 7.5 - 10.0 index. (Flight spread for each flight may be adjusted, depending on entries, (+ or - .5)

Note: Senior Professional flight for players age 50 and older and Senior Amateur flight (index 3.9 or lower) for players 55 or older, as of April 20, 2024.

The Committee will use the lowest GHIN INDEX in the last 12 months as of April 10, 2024 to determine flights within the Divisions.
