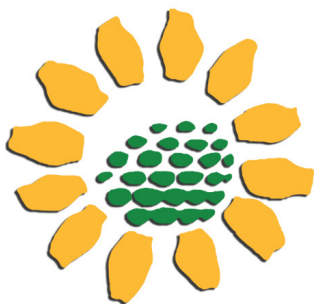




HAWAII STATE OPEN

54-HOLE STROKE PLAY DECEMBER 3-5, 2026

COURSE Kapolei Golf Course - Kapolei Hawaii

TOURNAMENT USGA Rules shall apply during the 54-hole stroke play event. The tournament champion shall be the player with the lowest 54-hole gross score. In the event of a tie, a sudden death playoff will determine the champion.

- The 2026 HAWAII STATE OPEN Tournament Committee has set a **field limit of 120** male and female entries to include amateurs, professionals, approved tournament players and/or Sponsor-exempt golf professionals.
- Electric carts will be provided during tournament play. Two carts per foursome.
- Players must register with the starter 20 minutes prior to tee time.
- Tee times for Round #1 - will be posted **after 12 noon on Friday, November 27, 2026.**
- Players will be repaired each day by score within each flight division.
- The committee shall determine flights for each division and may adjust the index by +/- (0.5) depending on total entries.
- The committee has the right to change a person's flight upon entry or anytime after 36 holes of play.
- Players shall be responsible to have a digital device that connects to the internet for the purpose of recording scores into Golf Genius.
- Approved USGA devices that measure or gauge distance only will be allowed during the tournament.
- All Professionals in this event will adhere to the policies and governance of the Aloha Section PGA.

DIVISIONS

The Men's competition will have two (2) Divisions - **Men's Open** (professionals and amateurs) with an index up to 4.2, and **Men's A-Flight** (4.3 to 7.6). Within the Men's competition there are three (3) flights - Professional, Men's Championship, and Men's A-Flight. **After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties. The tournament champion will be from the Men's Open Division.**

The Women's competition will have one (1) Division - **Women's Open** (professionals and amateurs) with an index up to 10.0 - a minimum of six (6) entries are required to open this division. Within the Women's Open there are two (2) flights - Women's Professional and Women's Amateur - a minimum of three (3) entries are required to open each respective flight. **After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 25% plus ties and/or eight strokes from the lead score.**

The Men's Senior competition will have one (1) Division - **Men's Senior Open** (professionals and amateurs) with an index up to 6.5. Within the Men's Senior Open competition there are two (2) flights - Professional and Amateur. All entries MUST be age 50 or older by December 3, 2026. **After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties for each respective flight. Senior Professionals and Senior Amateurs will be paired together each day.**

The Committee will use the lowest GHIN INDEX in the last 12 months as of November 26 2026 to determine flights within the Divisions.

Entry Fee includes cart & green fees for tournament dates. It does not include any practice round fees.

DEADLINE	Entry forms and all applicable fees are due at the Aloha Section PGA Office by WEDNESDAY - NOVEMBER 25, 2026 at 4:30pm. Players not among the first 120 accepted will be put on a wait list. All late entries (received after November 25th deadline) will be accepted on a space available basis and assessed an additional \$100.00 late charge.
